

Pre-Operative Instructions for Laser Vision Corrective Surgery

- 1. If you wear hard contact lenses, they must be removed and left off for three weeks before your examination because they change the shape of the cornea. If surgery is delayed, they may be worn until the time of surgery once the examination is completed.
- 2. Daily wear soft lenses must be removed three days before your examination.
- 3. Continuous wear soft lenses must be removed three days before your examination.
- 4. NO eye make-up on the day before and on the day of surgery.
- 5. Earrings must be removed prior to surgery.
- 6. Do not wear perfume, aftershave, or deodorant on the day of surgery. The fumes can interfere with the laser.
- 7. We recommend wearing long pants and having a jacket available because the laser room is cool. 8. Make sure you have someone to drive you home on the day of surgery.
